## DATES:

- Thursday 04/04/2019
  - 12:30 WARM-UP SINGLES OPEN. Entry fee 5€. Cricket handicap. With more than 128 players straight KO.

## 17:00 - FLAG PARADE & TEAM SELECTIONS TOURNAMENT:

- Cricket 2 players in one score, last game 4 players in two scores.
  - Each country can register up to 3 selections, one in each level:
    - 1. Men's Team Level 1.
    - 2. Men's Team Level 2: only players with <3.70 picture MPR.
    - 3. Women's Teams.

TIMBAS RADIKAL: Single Cricket with handicap.

- Level 1: 501 DI/DO, split bull 25/50.
- Level 2 & 3: 501 OI/MO, full bull 50/50.

  - Entry fee 5€ (registration on site).
  - 501 OI/MO, full bull 50/50.
  - For players eliminated or not playing singles.
- 20:00 JUNIOR SUB-16:
  - Free entry on site.
  - For players born as of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2003 (present documentation) and eliminated or not playing in singles.
  - 501 OI/MO, full bull 50/50.

- Level 1: 501 Team DI/DO, split bull 25/50.
- Level 2 & 3: 501 Team OI/MO, full bull 50/50.
- Other levels: 501 Team OI/OO, full bull 50/50.

#### 19:00 – MIXED TRIPLES (ATENTION: WILL BE PLAYED IN NARROW BOARDS)

- Teams of 3 players, a woman minimum per team.
  - Max. 10,00 MPR per team.
  - 701 MO split bull 25/50 the 3 players on the same score.
  - Entry fee 30€ per team on site.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> game the woman diddles and starts all games.
  - For players eliminated or not playing teams.

# **NORMAS BASICAS**

#### ENTRIES:

- ✓ All players must be signed in by his operator.
- ✓ Deadline is **March 22<sup>nd</sup>**. Any modification after this date will incur in extra costs.

#### **GAME FORMAT:**

- ✓ All competitions are face to face without handicap, except the open & timbas.
- ✓ Free-Play machines.

#### DIDDLE:

✓ Toss a coin for **diddle** in the first game. Then count the holes, the closest dart to the center hole starts the game. Rest of the games alternative start. If the first dart hit the exact center hole, it must be taken off to allow the opponent to hit it.

#### **REARRANGE ORDER OF OUTPUT:**

✓ First game choose the team that won the diddle and starts (press the arrow to rearrange the starting order).

#### TEAMS:

✓ Teams play in two boards at the same time. If a player has to play two games at a time in different boards, he must play first the game with the lowest n<sup>o</sup> of game.

#### RANKING:

- ✓ Every player must have **Radikal ranking** (MPR or PPD). If they don't have one of the two, they will be assigned one based on his profile.
- ✓ A player with less than 200 games in his profile (adding those of PPD and MPR), will increase considerably the ranking for the championship.
- Levels are not set by the picture ranking of the player, the system takes into consideration the highest ranking between MPR, PPD, European Board ranking, online or presential leagues ranking, total of games played in his profile and players or teams that finished in the first 3 places in past Radikal tournaments.
- ✓ A player who has been in the top 3 in any category in a previous International tournament, will be able to play in higher level, regardless of their championship ranking.
- ✓ In Doubles or Teams if a player has a high MPR or PPD, will be able to play in higher level, even if he is playing with another player or players of lower MPR or PPD.

#### LEVELS A & B:

✓ Within a level there can be two sub-levels, eg. 5A & 5B. Both belong to the same level 5 but are separated into two brackets. The first 8 players of each bracket qualify to the final of the level. The prizes announced are for the final bracket of the level.



#### **TOUCH SCREENS:**

- Players must see the bracket and the timetables in the **touch screens**. The voice advises (PA system) are only as a courtesy, it is responsibility of each player to check the touch screens. Exception: If the organization determines that a game has to be played at a different time as the scheduled in the touch screens, the game will be played at the time set by the organizer.
- ✓ The competition system is the main referee to establish if the data of both opponents is being properly inserted at the machine. If one of the two teams has not entered the data in time, it will be checked in the system. The organization always has the power to make the final decision or any exception that may occur.

#### **IDENTIFICATION:**

✓ Players using **false** or wrong identification will be disqualified and not eligible for prizes. All players must have photo in his profile.

#### CAPTAIN:

✓ Every team must have a **captain**, who is the only one allowed to talk to the organization and referees.

#### SCORE:

- ✓ If a player passes the **throw line**, please notify it to a referee that will check if he continues with this action, in which case he will lose his next three darts. In no case will videos be reviewed to verify this fact. During a shot the dart must hit the target before the player's foot makes contact with the floor in front of the throw line.
- ✓ A player can not throw a dart again, except if a dart **falls** from the hand it may be thrown again, although in the fall it has exceeded the throw line.
- ✓ If a player throws in place of another, he will lose his next three darts.
- ✓ Darts can be corrected (maximum 3) if players change the start order and no darts have been thrown; or if the target has scored badly and the dart is stucked; or if it has been scored with the hand and the dart is stuck in the target.
- ✓ The machine is the referee, so when it shows something, it's right. There is an exception with the winner shot, if the machine marks something different where the winner dart is hit, a referee from the organization should say where exactly is hit the winner dart.
- ✓ If a machine resets due to **power failure** or other reason beyond control, the game will start over (replayed from the start).
- ✓ If a player is delayed throwing darts, he will be warned by a referee. If the delay continues he will lose the game.
- ✓ Any dress or object that is understood as an offensive reference or could be considered to be a lack of respect between players or operators, the organization will take measures about it.
- ✓ Virtual Darts reserves the right at any time to modify the rules of any competition on the event if needed to ensure the integrity of the competitions.
- ✓ Smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
